STATEMENT OF INSURANCE DISCLOSURE

*Flying Scotchman, Inc. carries insurance that provides coverage for student and renter pilots using Flying Scotchman, Inc. aircraft. You are covered under our insurance policy, with the following coverages and amounts.

*Bodily Injury Liability \$100,000 each person, \$300,000 each occurrence (excluding passengers).

*Passenger Bodily Injury Liability \$100,000 each person \$500,000 each occurrence.

*Property Damage Liability \$100,000 each occurrence.

*Aircraft Hull has deductibles of \$250 not in motion, \$1,000 in motion.

*Single-Engine Retractable Gear Aircraft \$250 not in motion, \$2,500 in motion.

*Multi-Engine Aircraft \$250 not in motion, \$2,500 in motion.

*These Hull deductibles and anything else not covered by insurance, shall be the financial responsibility of the pilot in command.

The insurance *does not apply* to any student, renter pilot or person:

A. Who operates the aircraft:

1. In violation of the Federal Aviation

Administration

Regulations applicable to: aerobatic flight, instrument flight, the operating limitations of the aircraft, minimum safe altitudes, night flying, student instruction, pilot certificates, and ratings.

2. For any unlawful purposes.

3. In any manner which requires a special permit or waiver from the Federal Aviation Administration, whether granted or not.

4. For any purpose or use for which a charge is made by the student.

B. Who lands the aircraft on or takes off from a roadway, farm field or other areas not designated, generally maintained and customarily used as an airport, for other than emergency reasons.

C. Who permits anyone else to operate the aircraft not approved by Flying Scotchman, Inc.

In addition to the requirements above, the student or renter pilot must meet the certification (including current medical and flight review) and experience requirements of the policy.
