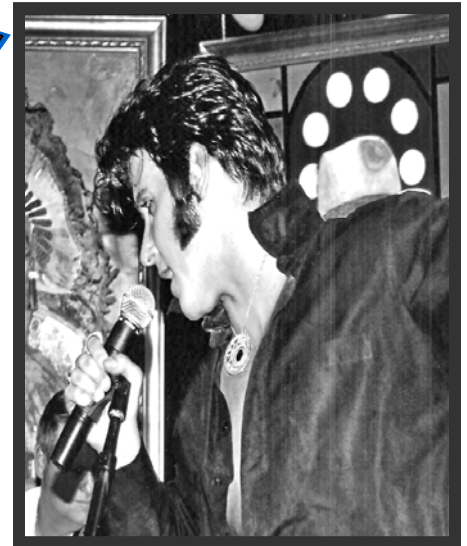
ELVIS HAS LEFT THE HANGAR!
